The numbers in Wendat

In Wendat, the word for 'ten' and 'tens' is **ahsenh**. In order to construct numbers between 11 and 19, we only need to use the word for 'ten', the word for the number of units added to ten, and the particle **iskare'**. Here is the sequence we use for this range of numbers:

TEN + NUMBER + ISKARE'

Iskare' is a particle which means 'it is so many units more!'

For example: 11

10 + 1 + 'it is so many units more'
ahsenh skat iskare'



The number two, **tëndih**, has a direct effect on the form of the particle **iskare'**!
 When we use **tëndih** 'two', the particle **iskare'** becomes **teskare'**!

For example: 12

10 + 2 + 'it is two units more'
ahsenh tëndih teskare'

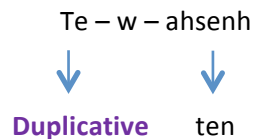
A little bit of culture...

For the Wendat people, the number two has a particular meaning attached to it: **duality**. Note the importance of this concept :

- ⇒ in certain actions : ex. it takes two legs to run, we grab objects with two hands;
- ⇒ in pronouns: there are forms which are specific to actions and events in which only two people are involved (ex. the two of us, they (2), you two, etc.);
- ⇒ in numbers;
- ⇒ etc.

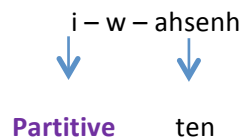
In Wendat, this duality is often represented by the forms t-/te-/ti-, a prefix that we call the **duplicative**.

When we want to form the number twenty, since there are two tens, we must use the particle **tewahsenh** 'to be two tens'.



Thus, 20: **tëndih tewahsenh**

Otherwise, whether we have three, four or fourteen tens, we use the particle **iwahsenh** 'to be so many tens'.



Thus, 40: **ndahk iwahsenh**

★ We use a prefix called the **partitive** when we want to enumerate things that are three or more.

Let's now build our numbers in Wendat!

Basic sequence that is used from **20 to 99 inclusively**:

Number of tens + IWAHSEN/TEWAHSENH + Number of units + ISKARE'/TESKARE'
